

#### **MEETING MINUTES**

#### Regular Meeting, September 7, 2013, Meadowbrook Farm

Meeting opened at 10 am by President Michael Ascher. Debby Evans handed out copies of the updated Constitution, By-Laws and Membership List. Bernie Wiener presented an example of a rhizomatous begonia growing out of a light volcanic rock as an example of a different way of growing begonias. Dave Hower handed out potted plants of B. 'Little Darling' as the new challenge plant for the membership to grow.

**Main Presentation**: Michael Ascher moderated a panel of DVB experts – Lucy Kuder, Tony Ashton, Helene Stephenson, Janet Welsh and Denise Conklin – on the care of rhizomatous begonias. The panel discussed their own personal experiences with growing begonias in general, and rhizomatous begonias in particular, covering soil, watering, propagation, light and fertilizing. Most of the discussion centered around optimum watering – the general consensus was to not water until the soil feels dry to a finger poked in a short distance.
